Dear Dr. _____ (ophthalmologist or optometrist),

Our office is now using the Enfant[®] Pediatric VEP Vision Testing System to help detect vision deficits in children. Since you may begin seeing referrals from us, we thought you would like a description of the test and examples of testing results.

As you may be aware, Visual Evoked Potential (VEP) technology has been used in hospitals, teaching institutions, and research sites for many years. Traditional VEP testing can take 45 minutes or longer and usually requires a trained VEP specialist to interpret the results. Diopsys, Inc. has simplified the technology and created a patient and practice friendly office-based VEP test that takes 5-7 minutes to administer and gives the Pediatrician a Pass/Fail result.

A clinical study published in the Journal of AAPOS evaluating the Enfant[®] showed that the device has a 97% sensitivity and 80% specificity. The paper is included with this letter. Also included are examples and a description of the Enfant[®] VEP test results.
